**ASSIGNMENTS:** each chaperone will have a group of 7-9 students to supervise for the trip. You will receive a list of student names and grades, as well as your bus number assignment, when you arrive on Friday morning.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** please ensure that you have accounted for all of your students <u>at each transition point</u> (when we board the buses in Grandview, when we get off the buses at OSU, when we are seated in the auditorium, when we leave the concert, when we board the buses at OSU, and when we return to Grandview). Please also ensure all members of your student group are back in the school and accounted for, before departing the school after the event.

**STUDENT BEHAVIOR:** Students are expected to behave appropriately and follow all safety rules and adult instructions while on this field trip. This includes but isn't necessarily limited to:

- remaining seated while on the buses;
- following all instructions from OSU staff, chaperones, teachers, and other responsible adults;
- treating bus drivers, adult chaperones, teachers, all OSU staff members, and other concert attendees with respect and courtesy;
- remaining with their assigned group at all times unless they notify you and get permission to separate (eg to visit the restroom);
- appropriate concert behavior during the event (remaining quiet and seated, no fidgeting or other horseplay, etc);
- no fighting, arguing, shouting, rough-housing at any time.

We assume it goes without saying, but these same rules of conduct apply to you as chaperones!

You are all parents, so use your best parent judgment (and your best mom/dad voices!) to address any problems the first time they arise. If you have a student who is a repeated problem and does not respond to your instructions, please contact one of the teachers on the trip for additional assistance.
